- To invite all educational establishments to provide a detailed listing of their educational support needs, be that staffing, training of staffing, schooling equipment, school books and supplies for all students, building needs and the configurations of such, sporting equipment, sports grounds, curriculum development, clean drinking water, toilet facilities, power supply, satellite internet services, internet services in general, computers, etc.
- To instigate equal opportunity of education for girls with boys.
- To provide onsite kitchens and the provision of at least one meal a day for all those attending the education facility, particular those of school age.
- To bring about the establishment of teacher training facilities that is to generate educators in sufficient numbers to achieve leadership in education for Papua New Guinea.

TENTATIVE WISH LIST (Education)

1. Early Childhood Education (identify and fund a model school).

Kindly consider a pre-school to be established within every province. This may be centred in communities that the mothers can obtain employment. The mode of operation and management of a centre could have a combination of trained personnel with extended family supporting. The structure may vary to reflect the needs and customs of the town or large villages. Training of key staff is a priority leading to opening of pre-schools – this could be considered through regional campuses of Pascas University to be established.

2. Early Childhood Teacher Training program.

Living Feelings First is outlined in eight Pascas Papers (see reference reading at the end of this paper). These may be added to the materials that may be considered by the Education Leadership Team. The culture of the people in each region being accommodated, to be melded with the environment that presently existing and continues to emerge.

3. School library / resource centre in each province possibly in the model school.

We can consider establishing a model demonstration school in every province – and even more than one – or as many as seen appropriate. Each school when reviewing their library / resource centre, with no exceptions, can have their wish list considered, should they come forward with what they may require. This will need a significant administration team and appropriate resources to manage the logistics. This could also involve internet communications involving satellite, renewable power generation and laptops to be provided and installed.

4. Teacher professional development (in-service, workshop etc.) on various topics such as early literacy and numeracy including multi modal literacy), civic and citizenship education, basic health and hygiene. The teachers' professional development should be aimed at supporting the new curriculum in PNG: Standards Based Curriculum (SBC). A priority area would be providing training on Teaching and Learning pedagogies – HOW to teach, not really WHAT to teach to complement what the PNG government, through the PNG Department of Education, is doing. With online teaching and learning, teachers need to be trained on various technological content knowledge (TCK) such as using Google classroom, setting up zoom link and webinars, etc..

Consider the establishment of teachers' training campuses in provinces with potential teachers also being provided with scholarships to enable them to follow their passions and complete required training. Scholarships may be extended to providing housing and costs of living. These provincial campuses may be the start of Pascas University throughout Papua New Guinea.

5. Training on Leadership and Management in Schools aimed at school principals, curriculum leaders etc. to engaged in school policy development, implementation, and evaluation.

Again, Pascas University campuses in provinces to enable as many potential educators to be accommodated to build the numbers of true educators to a level that education throughout Papua New Guinea can be an example of what can be achieved in a short period. This will also require the flattening of the hierarchical controlling domination that prevails throughout the education system worldwide – it is this control that is stifling free flowing initiatives of many great educators. Workshops can be conducted at all appropriate Teacher Training campuses for all leader type educators.

- 6. Standards Based Curriculum materials supplied but insufficient for all schools throughout the country. Textbooks for different subjects except for Maths and Science developed by JICA (Japan International Cooperation Agency), then train them as well on how to use these Teachers' resources.

All materials and textbooks may be supplied. Uniforms may also be supplied. Kitchen facilities may be included in the schools and food supplied and prepared by catering staff for breakfast and lunch as required. The question is to ensure respect and acceptance of such support. Is it simply handed out? Is it invoiced to each student and announced as a scholarship? Is there a nominal payment from the student? It is to be free, however the student is to understand its importance in a way that is culturally acceptable.

7. Alternative education (adult and early school leavers) skills training to improve lives addressing inequities and promoting social justice concept. Begin by funding existing Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) schools with infrastructure, resources, (tools and equipment).

Pascas styled TVET Colleges may be established in each province and concentrated on providing Technical and Trade Skills and IT training to equip the school leaver to be immediately and valuably employed in the local workforce, thereby retaining more of the population in the regional areas. Again, the education is to be free. This maybe done with; "here are your fees and, congratulations, here is a scholarship".

8. STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) education – develop resource materials to help teachers to implement these various projects prescribed in the curriculum. Such as teacher workbook. Concept applied in projects. Materials / equipment needed for these to support.

This is a big task and it is for those with big overview sight and then detail focus to attend to the minute requirements. It will also be an ongoing evolution. Pascas is to support this agenda all the way.

9. Sport development in schools (Physical Education (PE) equipment, uniforms, etc.).

Sport is the only reason why many attend school. Education is meant to be fun. This is mostly lost in the controlling addictions of most people throughout the education world and elsewhere in our lives. Sport is an important component of the school syllabus and fields and courts and swimming pools may be established in each school and the necessary equipment and uniforms supplied.

10. Water tanks for schools and proper toilets facilities.

Water tanks and state of the art toilet facilities can be included in all schools as well as Teacher Training Colleges and TVET Colleges. Again, consider instructing an administration team to request what each education facility considers that it needs and then approve a delivery and installation operation.

11. Education material with foundations based on assumptions to be recognised for what they are – in error!

Our minds are addicted to untruth. Our minds cannot discern truth from falsehood. Consequently 98% of assumptions are wrong – the other 2% are flukes. Count the number of assumptions in research papers. We will then discover the reason why society is floundering!

12. Education of girls to be prioritised.

If a girl spends only 2 years at school, she is likely to have more than 7 children. If she spends 6 years at school, she is likely to have around 4 children. If she spends 12 years at school then she will have only 2 children. World poverty is best averted by the tool of education in the first instance.

Girls and women are closer to their feelings than boys and men. Consequently, it is through our feelings that we excel. The belief that men are to dominate the female is that leaders of the past understood that should females be allowed to fully express themselves through their feelings then the men with their control would be ended. Today we start that ending for the advancement of both women and men!

13. The potential within us all is incomprehensibly amazing – however it will NOT be revealed through our minds. Our potential and our true personality will reveal itself through our soul-based feelings – this is The New Way – our new way of living. We are to live feelings first, express our feelings, both good and bad without acting upon them, and to long to know the truth of what our feelings are bringing to our attention.

Living mind centric, as we are all taught to do so from birth and throughout all our walks of life, imprisons each of us into limitations of mediocrity. 

Our FEELINGS are our SUPREME GUIDES:






HEALINGends MIND-CONTROL!



OUR MIND constricts OUR FEELINGS!





<u>CHALDI COLLEGE – EDUCATION</u>: Nanna Beth – 3rd Celestial Heaven and James 28 July 2017

James: John has been wondering about how to set up schools and schooling under a tree, in keeping with it all being opposite to what we're all used to, can you give him any suggestions or point him in the direction he should look?

Nanna Beth -3^{rd} Celestial Heaven: These are some ideas he can consider - just suggestions John, we won't say it has to be this or that way, as you know, it's for you to work things out. So basically, what would you like John - how would you have liked school to be?



Schooling is voluntary. It should be made to be something children want to do, not something that's forced on them.

It should be fun, as in keeping the whole focus on making them feel good about all they are doing. Not artificially praising them or praising them over their peers, but just supporting and being personal with them, allowing them to respond and find their own way.

It should not be separated into classes based on age. Classes should involve all ages, for example, the younger ones can learn and watch and be helped by the older ones, but not forcing the older ones to help the younger, all voluntary and what would naturally happen, more like in a big loving family rather than segregated because of age or whatever. Perhaps the 5, or less, to 10 in one group, 11 to 16 in another.

Teachers are to be able to deal with children of all ages, and work to allow the student to progress at the students own pace. Special or extra schooling can be provided when necessary to students that want more.

The subjects should all be practically oriented. Everything offered and so accepted voluntarily. Reading, writing and basic arithmetic, all so as to help the child deal with the real world. Other subjects like psychology – morals and ethics, love and friendship, acceptance and tolerance of ALL feelings, particularly bad ones, resolving disagreements, expressing feelings and yet not necessarily acting on them – particularly the bad ones, all based around how to respect and treat other people how you'd like to be treated. And how if you hurt by infringing upon another's will, then you will have to suffer that same amount of hurt, either now or in spirit. 
James: So you don't force or coerce anyone to do anything they don't want to do. Because who wants to be treated that way – no one!

Feelings First is a way of living without any dogmas, creeds, rituals, cannon laws, hierarchy or controls of any kind.





Achieving Quality Education in Papua New Guinea

Over the years, Papua New Guinea (PNG) has been actively trying to improve its educational system. Education in PNG has struggled to instruct around two million elementary and primary-age children due to a lack of classrooms, teachers and basic facilities.

Without a quality education, even graduate-level students will be affected. They would have completed weak programs, leaving them ill-equipped to help in the country's development and unable to compete internationally.

PNG struggles with specific issues that make quality education difficult:

- Language barriers for foreign teachers speaking broken English
- Unreliable resource distribution and delivery of materials to the remote areas of PNG
- Under-qualified teaching staff
- Outdated curriculum
- Insufficient equipment

Quality education is the backbone of a country's human resources and considered the route to economic prosperity. <u>T.W. Schultz wrote</u>, "a country which is unable to develop the skills and knowledge of its people and to utilise them effectively in the national economy will be unable to develop anything else."

In South Asia, students are unlikely to be accommodated sufficiently because of the country's weak, unaffordable education system. South Asia holds 23% of the world's student population but spends only two percent (2%) of the world's total public expenditure on education. However, with an uneducated population, economic development is unlikely to occur, unless a large amount of foreign aid is provided.

In April 2000, in attempt to reform education in PNG, representatives of 164 countries met in Senegal to discuss the issues that relate to education. Through this, six Education for All (EFA) goals were adopted.

One goal in particular was ensuring that by 2015, all children – especially girls, children in difficult circumstances and those belonging to ethnic minorities – have access to and receive completely free and compulsory primary education of good quality.

In addition to EFA, Australian prime ministers worked with the PNG government and other donors to implement the reform agenda of education in PNG between 2007 and 2015. Its prime ministers committed to increasing PNG's basic education net enrolment rate from 53% in 2007 to 70% in 2015. School enrolment, secondary (% gross) in Papua New Guinea was reported at 47.5 % in 2016

Education in Papua New Guinea is managed through nineteen provinces and two district organisational units. It is tuition-free and attendance is not **compulsory**. With a literacy rate of 64.2%, **Papua New Guinea** has the lowest literacy rate in Oceania.

The benefits to PNG have been multifaceted:

- Increase of net basic education enrolment (from 2007 to 2009) from 52% to 63%t, even to 98% in 2013
- Increase of school competition rate (from 2007 to 2009) from 45% of enrolled students completing grade eight to 56%

- Construction of 176 double classrooms
- Procurement of 539,000 primary school textbooks delivered in the first half of 2010.
- In-service teacher training to 33,000 teachers
- Abolishment of school fees for basic education and subsidised fees for post-basic education institutions, not including universities

Despite these improvements in the system of education in PNG, many issues remain. There is still a lack of teachers able to provide quality educational instruction. Many children still do not complete the entire nine-year program. In remote highland areas, only seven percent (7%) of children receive any schooling at all.

It has been anticipated that the pace of PNG education will be changed by 2020. There must be improvement in both the quality of required teacher training and quantity of manpower, for neither economic nor social change is likely to occur without an educated population.



Mapping Global Happiness Levels In 2021



"Are you happy?" is a deceptively complex question to both ask and answer.

It's generally understood that having enough money to cover your needs and wants can help you live a relatively happy, comfortable life – and recent research shows this relationship may increase linearly as income levels grow, as well.

However, as Visual Capitalist's Iman Ghosh details below, there's much more to it than that. Happiness levels depend not just on financial security, but also broader perceptions of one's social support, personal freedom, and more.



This series of map pulls data from the World Happiness Report to uncover the average scores of 149 countries between 2018-2020, and which ones emerged the happiest or unhappiest. We also look at the most and least improved countries in every region.

How is Happiness Measured?

First, let's look at the factors used to calculate world happiness levels. Some clear indicators are health and wealth, both metrics that have been steadily on the rise worldwide. The report takes these into account, weighting GDP per capita and life expectancy at birth into the scores.

The report also looks at more intangible aspects, collecting survey responses around:


- Social support
- Freedom to make life choices
- Generosity
- Perceptions of government / business corruption
- Positive or negative effects (Recent experience of emotions)

This year, there was a natural focus on the negative affect measure of the coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic on happiness levels, such as exacerbating mental health risks. In addition, such measurements varied depending on each country's response to the crisis.

Looking Closely at Regional Happiness Levels

Worldwide happiness comes in at an average score of **5.5**, a marginal improvement since our previous coverage of this report in 2019. Let's dive into regional outlooks for happiness levels.

North America Current Mood: Happy (6.1)



back efforts to reduce poverty and widening inequality.

Canada retains its spot as the happiest country in North America, although its overall global ranking has dropped over the years. In 2019, it was ranked in 9th place globally, dropping to 11th in the 2020 edition, and declining further to 14th place in this year's report.

Haiti continues to fare poorly as the unhappiest in the region, with an average annual GDP growth of only 1.3% over 20 years. Its weak economy and political instability have been worsened by the pandemic—setting

South America

Current Mood: Content (5.9)



With the largest middle class in the Americas—60% of its population—and a miniscule 0.1% extreme poverty rate, Uruguay is the happiest South American country. The nation has also achieved equitable access to basic services, from education to electricity.

The trio of Colombia, Ecuador, and Venezuela are experiencing different stages of progress in happiness levels, but their relationship is very much interdependent.

Venezuela and Ecuador face similar economic challenges and sharp declines in oil prices. Venezuela is additionally acutely affected by socio-political unrest, triggering a mass exodus of citizens to Ecuador and Colombia alike. The silver lining is that the influx of highly-educated Venezuelan migrants may provide a 2% boost to Ecuador's GDP.


Colombia, the most improved country, has halved its poverty rate in the last decade. In addition, it has welcomed almost 2 million Venezuelan migrants as of Dec 2020—and plans to provide them up to 10 years of protective status.

Europe Current Mood: Happy (6.4)

Finland remains at the top of the leader-board as the world's happiest country. This year's ranking was also influenced by high levels of trust in the way the COVID-19 pandemic was handled.

Meanwhile, the shock of the COVID-19 crisis is expected to be short-lived in Croatia, which is the most improved country. This is partly due to its steady pre-pandemic economic gains, although risks remain.

In the unhappiest country of Ukraine, conflicts continue to cause stress on its politics, security, and economy. In particular, government corruption remains a big public issue.




Middle East and Central Asia

Current Mood: It's Complicated (5.3)

Saudi Arabia is the most improved country in the region, as it continues to reduce its oil dependence, diversify its economy, and bolster its public services. It has also been making some progress towards gender equality.

The tourism and hospitality industries contribute nearly 20% of Jordan's GDP—and COVID-19 has caused a prolonged economic decline in the country along with the headwinds of these industries.



Although Afghanistan has seen improvements in access to basic services and its agricultural economy, challenges remain with prolonged conflict and violence. A postpandemic recovery in the world's unhappiest country might take several years.


East Asia and Oceania

Current Mood: Neutral (5.5)

Both New Zealand and Taiwan saw a successful COVID-19 response and recovery boosting their positions in the global happiness rankings. In fact, New Zealand was the only non-European country to make it into the top 10 on the global happiness list.

Note: As the report only covers 149 countries, "Oceania" only refers to Australia and New Zealand in this instance.

Although India remains the unhappiest country in the region, it also showed the most improvement overall, possibly due to its increased access to basic services. Notably though, the pandemic caused a sharp economic contraction in real GDP by 23.9% year-over-year in Q1'2021.





Africa

Current Mood: Unhappy (4.5)

In July 2020, the island nation of Mauritius joined Seychelles to become the second high-income country in Africa, helping cement its status as the happiest in the region.

Zambia, the most improved African country, has one of the world's youngest populations by median age—which presents long-term opportunities for labour force participation.



On the flip side, agriculturally-reliant Benin struggles with high poverty, with close to 40% of the population living below US\$1.90 per day.

Zimbabwe, the unhappiest country, has been through not just natural disasters but financial disasters too. It experienced hyperinflation of **786%** in May 2020, accompanied by an equally sharp rise in food prices.

Although each country has been uniquely impacted by the pandemic, it's clear that on the whole, happiness

levels take into account so much more. How will future rankings look like in a post-pandemic world?

The Build Back Better World 'B3W' Partnership Could Finally Break the Belt and Road

When nations are freed from China's oppressive debt practices, economies across the world can achieve sustainable growth through trade, stability and collective prosperity.

U.S. President Joe Biden's first trip abroad showcased America's return to the world stage, where it is once more leading the vanguard of like-minded trans-Atlantic Allies—tied together by shared values of Democracy, Human Rights, and the Rule of Law. However, to say this was simply a "return to normal" is selling it short.

Following the G-7 Meeting in the United Kingdom early in Biden's trip, the White House announced an Agreement to form the Build Back Better World Partnership—or the B3W—which would leverage the G-7's Development Finance Tools in investments in low- and Middle-Income Countries around the Globe.

Today, the developing world faces a staggering US\$40 Trillion Infrastructure Investment gap that undermines Global Development and sustains poverty. Without critical Infrastructure—like Stable Power Grids, Hospitals, High-Speed Internet, Environmental Resilience, Roads, and Ports—economies around the world are unable to modernise or provide for their populations. And when Infrastructure Projects are announced, they are too often doomed to fail because they fall short on funding; are mired in corruption; do not consider or adequately incorporate critical areas such as climate, health, and digital technology; or suffer from a lack of clear governance standards.

Under the last administration, the United States retreated into an America-alone policy that ceded leadership to rival nations that were more than eager to fill the void. Not only did American diplomacy devolve into grievance politics that alienated the United States' closest allies—damage Biden worked to mend on his trip—but the United States also pulled back from developing countries.

In contrast, China's Belt and Road Initiative is set to invest more than ONE TRILLION US DOLLARS (US\$1tn) across more than SIXTY (60) Countries around the world to meet the glaring need for Infrastructure. Of course, *Belt and Road Loans come with significant strings attached and a model utterly lacking in transparency, good governance, and labour or environmental standards*. And China's Infrastructure Investments are a Trojan-Horse to help it expand its Political, Economic, and Military Reach at tremendous cost to host Nations and at America's strategic expense.

Yet, with a United States retreating behind its Own Borders, it is hard to be critical of Governments willing to take the only offer on the table. That's especially true now, given the destructive COVID-19 Pandemic that has devastated economies around the world and put greater strain on already stressed Health Infrastructures.

These realities underscore why 'B3W' is an opportunity for the wealthiest like-minded Countries to mobilise their collective capacity for spurring Private Investment where it is most needed. Mobilising CAPITAL will be B3W's primary challenge, but it is time for the United States to move from promises to tangible action. The United States and its G-7 Partners must develop new tools to spur Market-driven Investments. They also need to coordinate with Multilateral Development Banks and Financial Institutions to crowd in sustainable, Private Capital.

To counter the Belt and Road model, the United States should work with Partners to emphasise and demand transparency and high standards from the outset of the Build Back Better World initiative. Countries around the world are starting to see the value in **prioritising equity and sustainability within their Economic Growth and Development Models.** 'B3W' should embrace those principles by ensuring that environmental and labour protections and transparency are built into the partnership's processes as safeguards against corruption and poor governance. Pushing for a common set of standards across the major Multilateral Institutions and Development Banks would go a long way in ensuring Infrastructure Projects adhere to recognised Safety and Environmental Standards, and that there is pressure on China to change its practices as well. The United States and its Allies must also consider opportunities to strengthen and expand Technical Assistance where needed to support Developing Countries in implementing transparency and good governance mechanisms around Infrastructure Projects and Trade.

'B3W' also provides an opportunity to rethink what Infrastructure looks like in today's world. The United States should ensure that investments are reliable, affordable and sustainable. In addition to this, the United States must consider how Technical and Human Capital limitations in many Low-Income and Lower-Middle-Income Countries present unique challenges in transitioning to Clean Energy Sources. It is important we ensure a just transition that supports Sustainable Economic Growth in Developing Countries as we work with them to address Climate Change and facilitate Power Sector reform. The International Community must assist Developing Countries with knowledge and Technology Transfers to build out diversified and reliable Critical Infrastructure and Human Capacity in these Sectors. Supporting the Green Climate Fund is one critical component in achieving this goal for a just and sustainable transition.

'B3W' must not invest simply to compete with China but because a high-standard, transparent, and environmentally and financially sustainable approach will benefit countless Nations around the world,

bolstering governance and global economic stability. Indeed, it would be a mistake to view the developing world solely through the prism of great-power competition with Russia and China. The United States needs to engage, for example, African Nations on their own merits, understanding that cooperation on economic growth, development, and good governance practices serve each Country's mutual interests. That means refraining from a top-down approach and working with Regional Organisations, Civil Society, and diasporas to drive Investments.

The Ensuring American Global Leadership and Engagement Act, Legislation I introduced to respond to the challenges posed by China, embodies many of the same principles defining 'B3W'. It assists Developing Countries in establishing independence from China by providing alternatives to Chinese Assistance and Financing. It creates a Whole-of-Government effort to counter predatory lending, especially in the Critical Energy Sector, and positions the United States Government to Co-finance Infrastructure, Climate Resilience, and adaptation projects to provide sustainable alternatives to the Belt and Road Initiative in the Indo-Pacific and especially to vulnerable Nations in the Pacific Islands and the Caribbean. As 'B3W' begins to take shape, it is a relief to see that the G-7's values of Environmental Sustainability, Transparency, Social and Labour Safeguards, and Anti-Corruption form the foundation of this initiative as well.

It will be incumbent on Congress to provide tools for this crucial multilateral undertaking and work with the administration and its Trans-Atlantic counterparts to mould the framework of 'B3W'. The world is far smaller than it was at the dawn of the 21st Century. The greatest challenges we face today are rarely contained behind National Borders. When failing Health Infrastructure allows a Pandemic to mutate and spread, it affects us all. When Climate Change or crumbling economies cause Mass-Migration, it dominoes across Regions. But when Roads and Ports are built, when innovation is unlocked with Digital Infrastructure, and when Nations are able to Invest-Free of China's oppressive Debt enforcement and Asset Seizure, Economies across the World can achieve Sustainable Growth through Trade, Stability and Collective Prosperity.

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
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
