

BLOOD PURIFICATION



These unique systems (above) have been developed over 22 years of intense research. They have been tested in several invivo studies involving thousands of patients.

The unique molecular structure of oxygen atoms have several therapeutic and healing mechanisms when introduced into the patient's blood. They have antiviral, antibacterial, antiprotozoic and antifungal applications.

Primarily there are two ways that the treatment can be applied. One is by IV injection, that is known Vos Amo Direct (Direct Delivery System). The other is the Apheresis process, 'similar to dialysis', where the blood is drawn from the patient in an extra-corporal loop and by using a specialised mixing chamber as pictured below.


The pre-saturated oxygenated blood, is then converted into varying forms of molecular oxygen, within the blood itself, and transported over the entire systemic system. A major contribution in which this new blood purification system can be applied, is in the treatment of stored blood and blood components, particularly in the application from donor to bag, from bag to bag, and from bag to recipient. Proven efficacy of the technology has been in the total elimination of other viral and biological warfare proteins.

One of the most important mechanisms of this process is in stimulation of the immune system and the detoxification of bodily functions. The application of these treatments are very easily applied, allowing doctors and nurses to be trained comfortably within 72 hours by fully competent international trained personnel.

These unique blood purification units (above) will also eliminate cellular mechanical shear, which is caused by forcing blood cells through a multitude of hollow fibre semi permeable membranes. Although not shown in the photograph above, there are two ferrite clamps providing alternating electromagnetic field polarization, breaking down all the nitrogenous components within the blood by destabilizing their subatomic structures, all renal and peritoneal dialysers (without exception) cause

significant amounts of cellular trauma upon the blood entering the membranes. As can be seen from the picture, the blood is merely recirculated through the capillary coil and the pre-supersaturated oxygenated blood, is then subjected to four incrementally spaced UV frequencies in the nanometre range.




KINESIOLOGY & PHYSIOTHERAPY



Kinesiologists centres provides Physician, Physiotherapist and Kinesiologist diagnostics and recommendations to insurance providers and instructs rehabilitative techniques to the individual insured. Teams consists of a Physician, Physiotherapist, Psychologist and four Kinesiologists all with extensive experience and knowledge in their respective disciplines. The educational approach to rehabilitation delivers the knowledge and techniques clients require to reduce pain and restore standard of living by increasing joint range of motion and functional strength. A flexible and adaptable problem based approach takes into consideration the needs of both the client and the insurance provider and is in turn both efficient and cost effective.

HYDROTHERAPY



PAIN CLINIC

Reducing pain is the first and most important need for any sufferer, especially a cancer sufferer. It is a patient's right to have pain relief. You may be in excruciating pain, and on morphine because no other painkiller "touches it". Or you may be stoically "putting up" with it, not sleeping, barely able to get up from your chair to get to the bathroom. Pain is the true master of us all. It even takes away our initiative to get well. If a cancer sufferer has decided to give up the battle, this wish should be understood and respected. But removing pain can change all that! And initiative and determination to conquer this disease can return.

A Pain Clinic is annexed to a Cardiac Clinic in the following way:

Provide a full range of analgesic techniques, aids for rehabilitation and stress management. Post operative cardiac patients require substantial pain relief, usually pharmacologically. Additional hydrotherapy could speed post-op recovery rate. Furthermore, relaxation training including biofeedback and psychological rehabilitation would be valuable from the points of both:

Preventative – stress management helps avoid re-occurrence, etc.

Rehabilitative – helps avoid post surgical neurosis and depression.

A Pain Clinic annexed to a cardiac clinic would place more emphasis on the following services:

Psychologist, physiotherapy, pharmacology (usually the surgeon undertakes the role of pharmacologist).

A Pain Clinic annexed to a Cancer Clinic would place more emphasis on the following services:

Anaesthetist, Neurosurgen, Rehabilitation and Relaxation, Pharmacologist (being a general physician).

These twelve specialty groups will constructively expand as further expertise is added to the Clinic encompassing additional modalities. Service delivery will be managed by Streamers who will construct appropriate programs for patients. Focus is upon treating the cause rather than just the symptoms.

What Is Alternative Medicine?

Alternative medicine is any form of practice that is outside the realm of conventional modern medicine. It covers a broad range of healing philosophies, approaches, and therapies. Most of these treatments and health care practices are not taught widely in medical schools. Examples are naturopathy, chiropractic, ayurveda, homeopathy and acupuncture.

What is Complementary Medicine?

If alternative medicine or therapy is used alone or instead of conventional medicine, it is called "alternative" medicine. If the treatment or therapy is done along with or in addition to conventional medicine, it is referred to as "Complementary Medicine" as the two practices complements each other. For example, many Chinese hospitals use acupuncture to reduce the pain during the surgery instead of anaesthetics. This is complementary medicine. Consider the use of sesame oil as a complementary treatment for cancer or the use of life style changes to combat heart disease. These are all examples of complementary medicine.

What is Holistic Medicine?


Many of the alternative practices pay attention to the mental, emotional, and spiritual aspects of health, in addition to the physical body. Holistic practitioners treat the "whole person" as opposed to the individual organs of the body where symptoms occur. The importance of self care and preventing illness are stressed by holistic practitioners.

This is the focus of Pascas Health.

DIAGNOSTIC & IMAGING

GENERAL RADIOGRAPHY

This is using X-ray in the most basic form and is the most popular of all imaging methods. It is used to assess the chest and to demonstrate broken bones. At our facility several X-ray rooms are available for this type of service. One room is equipped for chest work only. Another is designed for Accident and Emergency patients. The other rooms are available for routine cases such as those from casualty, clinics and private doctors offices.



FLUOROSCOPY

This is an imaging method which allows radiologists to view certain parts of the human body realtime. It is commonly used to demonstrate abnormalities of the gastrointestinal tract such as ulcers and other disorders of the digestive system. Examinations to demonstrate the urinary system are also done in this area.

MAMMOGRAPHY

Mammography is used to image the breast and allow radiologists to detect early breast cancer. Mammography can detect breast cancer even before it can be felt. It is currently the preferred method of screening for breast cancer. Mammography can save your life through early detection of breast cancer. Ladies who are 40 years and over may visit our mammography unit for annual mammograms without a referral from a doctor.

NUCLEAR MEDICINE

Nuclear Imaging demonstrates physiological processes rather than anatomical structures. In this type of imaging radioactive drugs (radiopharmaceuticals) that emit gamma rays and are attracted to the organ of interest are injected in the patient's bloodstream. The nuclear camera is used to take films as the pharmaceutical enters and concentrates in these tissues or organs. By tracing the blood activity the resulting nuclear medicine images demonstrate the biological activity of the organ or the vascular system which nourishes it.

Nuclear Medicine has a wide variety of uses, including the diagnosis of cancer, detecting kidney malfunction and other abnormalities in bones, tissues and organs.

COMPUTED AXIAL TOMOGRAPHY (CAT SCAN)

CAT Scan involves the use of a sophisticated x-ray equipment and computers to produce cross sectional images of the human body. CAT Scan is used for a broad spectrum of imaging needs such as brain, spine and abdomen. CAT Scan is also useful to evaluate the extent of some types of trauma injuries.



CARDIAC CATHETERIZATION AND ANGIOGRAPHY UNIT

This unit is used to perform specialized radiographic examinations of the heart and also to demonstrate various arteries and veins in the human body. Members of the radiology and cardiology departments work as a team to provide cardiac services in this area. Patients who need to be examined in this unit need special psychological preparation and must be admitted as ward patients before having their examination done.




ULTRASOUND

Ultrasound uses high-frequency sound waves as its imaging source. It was first utilized some 55 years ago. This medical technology's non-radiation nature has made it the modality of choice for obstetric and gynaecological procedures. Ultrasound is used to demonstrate abnormalities in various parts of the body such as the thyroid gland, pelvis abdomen and others.




MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING (MRI)

MRI uses a powerful magnet and radiofrequency waves to create the images. It is a relatively safe method of examining various parts of the body for disease or injury. Powerful MRI system delivers images with the diagnostic clarity that doctors require. MRI does not emit x-rays therefore there is no need for fear of radiation.




PHARMACY





Any supplement used daily should be as safe as food and water. Even the smallest amount of pollutant becomes more important due to daily accumulation of whatever toxins are present. Food and water have a safety feature built into them – they are both changed in source and variety during the day. A vitamin or mineral tablet, on the other hand, stays the same, bringing with it the same processing pollutants day after day after day.

No one should be given supplements that have not had a final analysis for heavy metals (particularly lanthanides, solvents and synthetic dyes). Cancer patients, especially, suffer from the least amount of toxicity; it's a matter of life and death for them.

The Pascas Health Sanctuary Pharmacy is reliant upon the final purity and quality testing applied to nutraceuticals by Biologics (WW) Nutrition Division.










RADIOTHERAPY & ONCOLOGY CLINIC

MULTIMODALITY AND MULTIDISCIPLINARY RELATIONS (not a Pascas service)

Oncology services include cancer surgery, radiation oncology and medical oncology. Many patients require combined modality treatment and, for some time, the integration of these services in specialised cancer treatment centres or by multidisciplinary teams has been advocated. The care of the cancer patient necessitates access to a wide range of medical specialists and the expertise of a diversity of other professions including specialist nurses, radiographers and counsellors. A comprehensive service requires the development of special groups with expertise in treating cancer in special anatomical sites such as the breast, colon, lung, lymph glands, urological sites, and head and neck. Full facilities for supportive care, pharmacy services, pain relief, rehabilitation and psychiatric assistance are also needed both within the hospital and in the community.



RADIOTHERAPY SYSTEMS



TELEMEDICINE SERVICES

Telemedicine can deliver a range of services including education, consultation, diagnosis, treatment, support, information storage, and governance. Health-related transactions can deliver services directly to users in a fast and cost-effective manner regardless of time and place.

Many instrumental investigations not accessible in the districts are now possible. There is maximum possible coverage of medical problems and less need for rural patients to be transported to district hospitals.

Services to be supported via telemedicine unit of Pascas Health Sanctuary are summarized below:

- Library of topic-specific information.
- Interactive courseware and training.
- Patient histories.
- Consultation.
- Diagnostics (including radiology, echo cardiology, pathology, ultrasound, high risk pregnancy monitoring, foetal heart monitoring, electro cardiology, stethoscope).
- Treatment.
- Rehabilitation.
- Medical supplies to patient.
- Medical supplies to institutions.

Public interest is rising at a phenomenal rate as reliable pathway for wellness and health. Typically there is one practitioner per 400 population. Such practitioner could represent any one of a wide range of modalities.

The Wellness Revolution now emerging suggests an enormous growth in public appreciation of the benefits that complementary medicine brings both in health as well as life style.

HOTEL

Cancer sufferers participating in the 21 day program developed by Dr Clark would see the capacity of Pascas Health Sanctuary Hotel with 420 rooms able to support 7,300 patients pa.

The Queensland Cancer Fund, in 1995, reported 5,770 new cases per 1,000,000 (3,260 males + 2,510 females) confirming a historical growth rate of 2.4% per annum in the rate of incidence.

WELLNESS INDUSTRY & COMPLEMENTARY MEDICINE

Healthcare is a misnomer, as one-seventh of the economy is really devoted to the sickness business – defined in the dictionary as “ill health, illness, a disordered, weakened, or unsound condition, or a specific disease”.

The wellness business is proactive. People voluntarily become customers – to feel healthier, to reduce the effects of aging, and to avoid becoming customers of the sickness business. Everyone wants to be a customer of the earlier-stage approach to health.

Sickness industry: Products and services provided reactively to people with an existing disease, ranging from a common cold to existing cancerous tumours. These products and services seek to either treat the symptoms of a disease or eliminate the disease.

Wellness industry: Products and services provided proactively to healthy people (those without an existing disease) to make them feel even healthier and look better, to slow the effects of aging, or to prevent diseases from developing in the first place.

PASCAS HEALTH SANCTUARY is focused on TREATING the CAUSE more so than TREATING the SYMPTOMS. Western medicine, also known as allopathy medicine, is focused upon treating the symptom whereas alternative medicine and complementary therapies are focused upon treating the cause.
